Arthropods are split into four groups: crustaceans, insects, arachnids, and centipedes
and millipedes. Crustaceans have chalky shells and 10-14 legs (although one pair of
legs might be pincers). <b>Insects</b> have six legs and bodies divided into three parts.
Arachnids have eight legs and bodies in two parts. Centipedes and millipedes are
